another go!



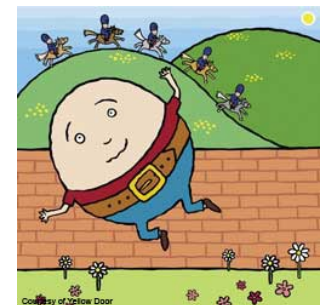
I'm a Little Teapot

"Tip me up and pour me out!"



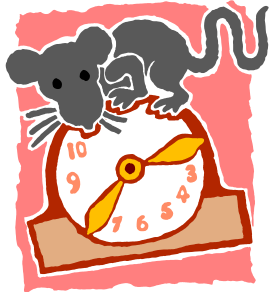
Humpty Dumpty
